ALBILLO MAYOR, CASTELLANA BLANCA Y PIRULÉS

La Nava is a vineyard with almost the entire Albillo Mayor variety, but as is common in the area in this type of plantation, the plot contains other white varieties in a minority, varieties such as Valenciano Blanco, Moscatel, Palomino Fino or Pirules . The vineyard was planted in 1936, through the traditional formation on a gentle slope facing East, in the area that gives it its name, located in the town of Gumiel de Mercado (Burgos), on the north side of the Duero River, the area has a marked continental climate with large temperature fluctuations between day and night. The soils are sandy with gravel areas.
